As a Clinician, Tyler regularly appears as composer in residence as well as guest clinician for honor bands.

Currently, Tyler serves as the Director of Music Production and Editing at Excelcia Music Publishing, Wingert-Jones Publications, Kendor Music Publishing, and RBC Publications. In his spare time, Tyler enjoys playing fantasy-world video games and building his own computers. Feel free to have lots of fun at M.25 when the low Strings take the melody over—get your audience involved and encourage them to clap along. I know many directors hesitate to start audience clapping, so M.33 is built to gently encourage them to trail off...here's hoping!
