I arranged these two beautiful folk melodies to have a way to teach our young players the graceful style of Celtic music. I wanted to give the low strings the opportunity to play the melody and, at the same time, try to provide interesting parts for the upper strings.

The Harp/Piano part is optional. It was written to be a challenge for most of our middle school Harpists. The piece can certainly stand alone without the Piano or Harp.

The contrast between the two movements should make this suite an interesting concert and festival selection. I tried to arrange the music with the teaching of fundamentals in mind.

Ms. Fishburn is a Past President of the Texas Orchestra Directors Association, the Texas Music Educators Association, and Mu Omicron, honorary fraternity for orchestra directors. She served on the Prescribed Music List Committee for UIL in 1987, was an appointed member of the Standards of Adjudication and Performance Practices for the Texas Music Adjudicators Association in 1987 and 1995, and was elected vice-president of the Texas Music Adjudicators Association in February 1995. As a member of TMAA, she has judged orchestra contests throughout Texas and its surrounding states, and is a clinician for United Musical Instruments USA, Inc.

Ms. Fishburn has served as a conductor for many TMEA All-Region Orchestras on the junior high and high school levels, as well as several All-State Orchestras. She is the coauthor of *Time for Strings*, a beginning orchestra method book, and has many published arrangements and compositions for string orchestra.
