Program Notes

Bach Largo is an arrangement of Bach's largo movement from the Concerto in D minor, originally written for two violins. Bach Largo is a grade 4 ½ piece with upper position work for each section of the orchestra. Fingerings have been added to assist position work. The symbol "-" has been used in the cello part to indicate necessary hand movement.
