**Toil and Trouble** is a three-movement suite for string orchestra where students explore minor tonality, glissando, dissonance, trilling, and *col legno* technique. Eerie, yet very melodic, this suite is perfect for a change of pace during your program.

#### **PROGRAM NOTES**

"Double, double toil and trouble: Fire burn, and cauldron bubble. By the pricking of my thumbs, Something wicked this way comes."

### PERFORMANCE NOTES

**Toil and Trouble** is a miniature suite that offers many opportunities to teach or reinforce various musical skills. The first movement, *Eye of Newt*, is driven by a simple dotted quarter, eighth rhythm in the lower strings while the upper strings provide contrast through *pizzicato* or a simple *glissando* melody in the key of E Minor. At the beginning, *glissandi* are ascending and played with the third finger to facilitate first position. Later *glissandi* use the first finger and descend into first position.

The second movement, *Toe of Frog*, moves to the key of A Minor and finds the melody in the cello and bass while the upper strings perform *col legno* on D. The 2nd violins and viola section then take over the melody. The trills at letter B should be fast and of equal volume to the low strings' ostinato.

The third and final movement, *Wool of Bat*, offers a chance to showcase dynamic contrast as well as dissonance while aggressively pushing forward in a return to E Minor. The pitch of B-flat can be found in all parts, making this movement a great opportunity to introduce/reinforce the fingering. The end of the movement recalls the first movement's *glissando* on top of the second movement's *col legno* and darker melody restatement.

#### ABOUT THE COMPOSER

**Bradd Parton** is a nationally-certified teacher with over twenty years of classroom experience. He has taught music in various forms from the kindergarten to collegiate levels. Mr. Parton currently serves as a middle school orchestra director in Spartanburg (SC) School District One as well as on the adjunct faculty at Presbyterian College. He received a bachelor's degree from Furman University and a master's degree from the University of South Carolina. In addition to music, Mr. Parton is also an active author and illustrator having published over two dozen books for children. He has presented his Alpha-Sketch educational art programs at schools and conferences across the Southeast.
